Breakfast


Breakfast is served as a **buffet** from **07:00 to 10:00** during the week and from **08:00 to 11:00** on weekends. This is included in the price of your room.


Check in / Check out





WHAT TO DO IN BASTOGNE?

Located in the heart of the Ardennes, Bastogne is nestled in a vast **forest region**. The municipality and its 40 villages and hamlets have a population of almost 17,000. Bastogne has gone down in history as the historic site of **the Battle of the Bulge**. Bastogne was even nicknamed the "Nuts City", after General McAuliffe's famous response to the German ultimatum.

On the outskirts of the city, the **German Foy Cemetery** and the American **Mardasson** Monument are visited by thousands of people who wish to pay tribute to the soldiers who fought and died here.

But Bastogne is not only a window on the past. It is a dynamic and active city with many **shops** open even on Sundays, the Latin Quarter, St Peter's Church, the Porte de Trèves... This is a bit like Paris in the Ardennes!

A LITTLE BIT OF HISTORY...

Bastogne, a place of **memory**, with a fascinating and moving history.

Back to the origins of Bastogne: **633**. The city played an important role as a royal residence with its **ramparts**, characteristic of the city with its two entrances: the Porte Saint-Pierre (High Gate) and the Porte de Trèves (Low Gate). Today, only the Porte de Trèves remains.

The city of Bastogne is known for its role in the famous **Battle of the Bulge**, one of the most bitter confrontations of the Second World War.

The American victory was a turning point in **the Second World War** as it dealt a damaging blow to the German forces fighting under Hitler.

On 16 December 1944, the Germans launched their last major offensive in the West. Bastogne was a key issue that the Americans had to defend at all costs.

On 19 December, Brigadier General **Anthony McAuliffe**, commander of the 101st Airborne Division, arrives in Bastogne with his division and establishes his headquarters in the barracks of Sub-Lieutenant Heintz.

On 22 December, he makes history: he answers the world famous line "NUTS"

to the German troops encircling Bastogne and demanding surrender. His short but powerful statement became a turning point in the Battle of the Bulge and remains to this day **a symbol of resistance**, of hope, but above all of pride for the people of Bastogne.






HISTORICAL MONUMENTS AND SITES


The Mardasson

The Mardasson Memorial is a tribute paid by the city of Bastogne in collaboration with the United States in recognition of the American troops who fought for the liberation of Europe during the Battle of the Bulge. A crypt has been decorated with mosaics designed by Fernand Léger. It is located at the foot of the monument in memory of the fallen.



The Barracks

The Barracks tour immerses you in the historical turning point brought about by the "NUT'S" replica. Experience the immersive remains of the barracks once occupied by General McAuliffe and his troops.

Sherman Tank

The Sherman tank has been completely renovated and is a must-see in Bastogne. This American tank belongs to the 11th Division and was stopped in Renuamont on 30 December 1944, after a German attack on the village. The crew was captured by the Germans and taken to a prison camp.

The Last Post of the "Path to Freedom"

The Freedom Road traces the route of General Patton's troops from Sainte-Mère-Eglise in Normandy to Bastogne. The last milestone was set at Mardasson in 1947.

The "Trèves" gates

(last remnant of the 14th century rampart)


The Porte de Trèves was originally one of the two entrances to the town. Around 1725–1730, it was transformed into a prison. Today, located behind St. Peter's Church, the Trier Gate (originally the Lower Gate) is so named because it indicated the direction of travel to the German city of Trier at that time.

German cemetery in Noville-Recogne

Not far from Bastogne is the small village of Recogne, which saw heavy fighting during the Battle of the Bulge. In the German military cemetery of Recogne are buried 6807 German soldiers.


Jacques Woods

The Bois Jacques, in Foy, still bears the scars of the fighting around Bastogne. There are remains of trenches and cavities dug in the ground to protect American soldiers from hostile fire.

In a modern and interactive setting, this museum offers us a new perception of the causes and consequences of the Second World War through the lens of the Ardennes counter-attack: the "Battle of the Bulge".



101 Airborne Museum

The museum and its historic building tell the story of the Battle of the Bulge. Display cases with realistic scenes and mannequins will take you back to the cold winter of 1944–1945. You will have the opportunity to visualise what the soldiers and locals endured during this long battle, including a visit to the basement, the hospital, various dioramas and objects. Behind a door, you will experience the bombing in a hidden shelter with a family. You will hear, see and feel the explosions as they were experienced by our fellow human beings during the war.

The museum in Piconrue

This museum of religious art and popular beliefs of the Ardennes is housed in the 17th century Bethlehem convent. The various exhibitions on display here invite visitors to discover the traditions and popular beliefs of the Ardennes and Luxembourg.

The site is designed to allow visitors to travel through the Ardennes and through time, in order to discover in an immersive way rural legends, the life cycle of an Ardennes citizen in the broadest sense of the term, as well as the literary and other works of local artists.

House of legends

In 2008, an annex to the museum in Piconrue, the House of Legends, opened its doors with completely new settings and innovative interactive educational content. The intention is to introduce visitors to the **legendary**heritage of the Ardennes. Visitors are invited to walk through the Ardennes forest. They will meet many fantastic creatures, both friendly and evil.




The castle of Bouillon (Bouillon)




Le Fourneau Saint-Michel et le Musée du Fer

Safety instructions for guests

How to prevent fire?

- 1. We remind you that smoking is strictly forbidden on the hotel premises.
- 2. Do not touch the electrical installation under any circumstances.
- 3. Do not use objects or liquids that could cause a fire.
- 4. Do not cook in the rooms with appliances that are not part of the hotel's equipment.
- 5. Make a reconnaissance of the escape routes near your room. These are indicated on a map posted on the entrance door of your room.
- 6. Do not dry clothes on heating appliances.

What to do in case of fire?

If you discover a fire or smoke, you should immediately notify the reception: dial 500 from your room telephone or +3261217778.

The staff are trained in fire fighting, evacuation of residents and are ready at all times to look after your safety until the fire brigade arrives. You are of course required to follow their instructions in the event of a fire.

- 1. In case of fire, you will be alerted by a siren.
- 2.In order to protect your airways, we advise you to keep a wet cloth or sheet in front of your nose and mouth.
- 3. Evacuate your room, close the (fire) door and take the shortest route to the exit or emergency exit. Make sure you keep the fire doors closed. Avoid smoky corridors.
- 4. Do not use lifts, they can become blocked in the event of a fire. Emergency exits and stairwells are clearly marked and lit, even when normal lighting is not available.
- 5. Group together in the hotel car park and wait for permission from the fire brigade before reentering the hotel.

General terms and conditions of sale and house rules of the hotel

In accordance with the Law, the present regulations are displayed in each room and at the reception of the establishment, and any guest taking possession of a room is deemed to have read them and to accept their obligations.

PRESENTATION: The hotelier is at liberty to refuse to receive guests whose dress is indecent and negligent, guests whose behaviour is noisy or incorrect, guests whose behaviour is contrary to public morality and order.

PAYMENT: The room rate is established by the day. Failure to pay will result in the immediate expulsion of the client, subject to legal proceedings for the payment of the amount due. In the event of dispute, jurisdiction will be attributed to the Judge of the Civil Court of Neufchâteau. The balance of the stay can be paid on arrival or departure. We accept the following credit cards: Visa, Eurocard-Mastercard, American Express, Diners, Maestro and Vpay. Bank cheques are not accepted. We ask everyone staying at our hotel to present an identity card at check-in. If you are unable to provide us with this document, we will be forced to refuse your request for room rental.

Bribe-taking: Bribe-taking is an offence characterised by the consumption of a paid good or service knowing that you are unable to pay or are deliberately determined not to pay, while pretending to be willing to pay.

The penalty for fraud is up to 3 months imprisonment and a fine of \leqslant 3500 in addition to damages.

ROOMS: The rooms are rented for the number of persons indicated on the leaflet received at check-in. In the event of a breach of this regulation, the hotel reserves the right to charge the client responsible for the cost of the room(s) corresponding to the number of persons found to be in excess, whether or not the client is present, at the room rates in force at the time of the breach of the internal regulations. The hotel will debit the credit card of the offending guest.

DEGRADATION: In the event of damage to the interior and exterior furniture, or damage to or theft of linen, the hotel reserves the right to charge the client for the cost of repair or replacement in an amount equal to the amounts incurred.

IN THE EVENT OF INTERRUPTION OF THE STAY: No refund will be made. Similarly, in the event of early departure, the stay is due in full. Late arrivals or early departures cannot under any circumstances give rise to a refund.

CANCELLATION CONDITIONS: For a free cancellation, please contact us 48 hours prior to arrival, after this time, the amount of the first night will be due. For a same day reservation, the cancellation or modification must be made before 4pm, after this time, the amount of the first night will be due.

NO PRESENTATION at the scheduled time will not give rise to a refund.

ACCESS TO ROOMS: The rooms made available to our guests are checked, functional and in good condition. Any occupation of the room entails "ipso facto" the recognition by the client of the inventory of the furniture according to the register kept by the hotelier. Our guests are invited to report any shortcomings immediately to the hotel reception. Rooms are available from 3pm onwards and must be vacated before 12 noon. In case of late check-out, an additional night will be charged. To keep the room for an extra night, payment must be made before 12:00, subject to availability. In addition, the room is intended for a specific number of people. In order to ensure the safety of the hotel, no additional persons should be accommodated. The management would like to draw the attention of its guests to the fact that the door of the room must remain closed.

PROHIBITIONS: According to the law of 1 July 2011, smoking is prohibited in all enclosed public places. It is also absolutely forbidden to smoke in the rooms for obvious reasons of safety and comfort (non-compliance will result in a compensation of 80€/night rehabilitation of the room). It is forbidden to use gas or electric appliances in the rooms other than those provided (e.g. stove, coffee maker, etc.) All sports equipment (bicycle, etc.) is strictly inside the establishment (common areas and rooms), a closed room is provided free of charge for the storage of your equipment.

ANIMALS: Animals are not allowed in the hotel.

DEGRADATION: We ask our guests to respect the premises and the decoration of the rooms. Children are under the full responsibility of their parents. In case of damage, the client will be held responsible.

FOUND OBJECTS: Any forgotten or found object can be sent by post at the client's request and expense.

BREAKFAST is served from 7:00 am to 10:00 am on weekdays and from 8:00 am to 11:00 am on weekends and public holidays in the breakfast room. Breakfast is served in the form of a free buffet, but it is not a supermarket. It is not allowed to take food away for later consumption. If necessary, a lunch box can be prepared by the hotel kitchen at a cost of €15 per box (designed as a one-person midday snack).

THE RECEPTION declines all responsibility for luggage or objects left in public areas. Please note that the reception closes at 22:30. For any late arrival, please contact us by telephone so that we can inform you of the access arrangements to the hotel. NISANCES: For the respect of the rest of the other guests, please do not slam the doors or make too much noise, especially between 9pm and 8am. Any neighbourhood noise caused by a person's behaviour may lead the hotelier to ask the quest to leave the establishment without the need to take acoustic measurements. This is especially the case when the noise generated is such as to disturb the peace and quiet of the guests (art. 544 of the Civil Code). A hotel room is a place of rest. Any business is strictly forbidden.

The hotel's internal regulations apply to all reservations. Any stay implies acceptance of the special conditions and the hotel's internal regulations.
